

Five-fingered glove made from red knitted outer fabric and grey woven fabric, with a leather strip and cow leather, both in grey. The gloves have red silicon strips on each of the finger tips. The entire glove is lined in black non-woven fabric. An intermediate lining is inserted between the outer layer and the lining. The glove is made from several pieces joined by seams and comprises palm, back and cuff
